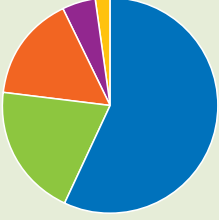

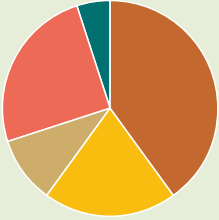

2012 Fun Facts

- 60,000 pancakes were consumed at the 2012 Sugar Bush Maple Syrup Festival.
- The water refilling station at the Kortright Centre replaced 25,000 plastic bottles.
- 300 migrating species of birds were recorded at the Tommy Thompson Park Bird Research Station.
- 600 camping sites were booked in TRCA's parks.
- 311,000 native trees, aquatic plants and shrubs were planted.
- Over 11,000 artifacts were recovered from 100 archaeological sites, some dating back as much as 12,000 years ago.
- 36 wetlands and 9 stormwater management ponds were monitored.
- 150 stations were tested for aquatic habitat and species monitoring.
- TRCA provided over 165,000 outdoor, environmental and cultural experiences to students of the Toronto region.
